



Michèle MAZZONE ESCOUBOE (Piano - France)

Having received the First prize in piano and chamber music at the Toulouse Conservatoire and the Prize for excellence from the Marguerite Long school in Paris, Michèle Mazzone devotes her life to playing the piano and teaching.

She performs in recitals in a large number of cities and festivals in the south of France: Agen, Cahors, Perpignan, Villeneuve-sur-Lot, Toulouse, Mediterranean and Quercy festivals.

The quality of her teaching is well known: several of her students have entered the major conservatories of Paris, Lyon, Marseille and Brussels; three of them have been invited to the international Piano Festival at the Jacobins in Toulouse.

For many years, Michèle Mazzone has participated as a jury member in the competitions of the higher grades of the Marseille Conservatoire. Throughout her career, she has worked with renowned pianists, many of whom have become friends.

Many famous pianists have taught master classes at her home, such as Bruno-Léonardo Gelber, Jean Doyen, Vencislav Yankoff, Pierre Sancan, Daniel Wayenberg, Pierre Barbizet, Paul Badura-Skoda, Catherine Collard, Philippe Cassard, Jacques Rouvier, Anne Quéffelec.
