*The 24th International Piano Competition of Ile-de-France, which will take place from **3 to 10 June 2023** in Maisons-Laffitte (Yvelines), is now open for registration.*

Under the honorary presidency of Anne Queffelec, this prestigious event welcomes each year some 250 candidates of more than 30 nationalities.

An international Competition open to all

The Competition welcomes all pianists, from beginners to advanced (*three French Conservatory Levels, Advanced and Excellence*), but also adult *Amateur Concert Pianists*.

The prestigious **Concert Diploma** category is restricted to professional pianists up to the age of 32. A true stepping stone in the artistic progression of this young generation, this category represents the showcase of future virtuosos on the international scene.

Jean-Claude Vanden Eynden, President of the Jury

The jury of the Competition comprises international pianists only.

The famous Belgian concert pianist Jean-Claude Vanden Eynden will chair the jury of the Concert Diploma, accompanied by Haruhi Hataand (Japan), Elza Kolodin (Poland), Ronan O'Hora (England) and Emmanuel Strosser (France).

The winner of the 2022 Edition, Danylo Saienko, will open the Competition with a recital at the Ancienne Eglise de Maisons-Laffitte, renowned for its high quality acoustics.

David Abiker, journalist and columnist with Radio-Classique, will ensure by his friendly presence the presentation of this evening.

8,000 euros in prize money, 16 recitals, masterclasses, workshops...

The winner of each category will receive a prize. The total prize money amounts to 8,000 euros, plus 16 recitals (Paris, Lyon, Toulouse, Lourmarin, Nohant), an internship in Budapest and a masterclass.
