Florence Pavie received lessons from Marcelle Heuclin, Reine Gianoli, Geneviève Joy and Jacques Rouvier at the National Conservatory of Music in Paris.

Her piano spontaneously unites with orchestras (concertos by Beethoven, Schumann, Rachmaninoff...), trios, quartets, quintets (Cras, Franck, Haydn, Schubert, Ravel...), with storytellers and actors, in musical trios traditional music from Brittany, Malian musicians, dancers, and during numerous international tours (Belgium, Mexico, Brazil, Algeria, Russia, Malaysia...), Florence performs regularly in recital, addressing the repertoire from the Baroque era to the present day.

Reflecting on the construction of its programs, she likes to give some insights and clues to help the audience better appreciate the musical encounters with the composers.

In addition, since 2015, she has been traveling in Brittany across the land and along the coast to meet the public in the streets, in the villages, with her van and her mobile piano, Le Piano Libre. She performs written music and improvisations.
